## Sixth Bargaining Session:

On July 19<sup>th</sup> the parties reviewed the written version of the July 13<sup>th</sup> proposal.

The Union asked clarifying questions concerning the Universities proposal; including the methodology and reasons for the University's proposal on how to use the \$500 FTE monies. The Union requested the next session be two weeks out.

## *Fifth Bargaining* Session:

On July 13<sup>th</sup> the University verbally presented a concept for a counter proposal on how to use \$500 FTE pool monies.

## Fourth Bargaining Session:

On June 29<sup>th</sup> the Union provided a written proposal for the expenditure of the \$500 FTE pool monies. The parties reviewed the proposal and the University asked clarifying questions concerning the Union's methodology and/or criteria on how they divided pool monies.

The University committed to providing a counter proposal for the next session.
